US127 to Jolly Road exit(#11). Turn left (Dunckel Rd). East on Dunckel to dead end (Collins Rd) Left on Collins Road, one and one half miles to Farm Lane-turn left onto Farm Lane and follow to entrance of Pavilion.

From the East or West

I96 to US127 (exit106b) North on US127 to Jolly Road exit (#11). Turn left (Dunckel Rd). East on Dunckel to dead end (Collins Rd) Left on Collins Road, one and one half miles to Farm Lane-turn left onto Farm Lane and follow to entrance of Pavilion.
